Example of an action plan for a Mentorship Program initiative

Using the action plan section of our Workforce Plan Template, create a description of each initiative. For example:

Mentorship Program. Who is responsible? Mentorship Program Coordinator, Managers, Employees. When will it be completed? 10/1/2014. Performance Indicators: How will we know we achieved our goal, and what will success look like? 30% manager participation by 5/1/2015; 50% rank/file participation by 5/1/2015; 80% of participants will report positive experience by first survey collection on 10/1/2015
